Please find attached a call for course proposals by visiting teaching staff for the University of A Coruña's International Summer School.

The University of A Coruña's International Summer School (<u>www.udc.es/iss</u>) offers a selection of three-week intensive courses taught by international faculty in the month of August that are open to Spanish and foreign undergraduates, graduate students and recent graduates.

Courses are taught in English, have an academic value of 6 ECTS credits, and are recognised as equivalent to optional courses of specific accredited undergraduate and graduate degrees of the University of A Coruña.

Faculty come from different universities and are renowned experts in their fields. They are active in academic research, consultancy or government.

Courses are an opportunity for local and foreign students and faculty to engage in an international experience and benefit from their mutual interaction in one of the best venues for a summer course in Europe.

Call for proposals

International faculty are invited to submit course proposals for the University of A Coruña's International Summer School (<u>www.udc.es/iss</u>) that will be held in A Coruña from 4 to 22 August 2014.

The University of A Coruña will help selected applicants to obtain funding from their home universities under Erasmus teaching staff mobility, and in addition will offer paid accommodation and meals in a university hall of residence. At the end of the course, the University of A Coruña will issue a certificate to the visiting teacher stating the title and level of the course, and the number of hours and credits taught.

Each course shall have a total teaching load of 42 hours divided in 14 three-hour sessions and will have an academic value of 6 ECTS credits.

Submissions should contain:

A course proposal including:

- The title of the course.
- A brief description of the course (max. 200 words).
- A list of topics.
- A reading list.
- A list of University of A Coruña degrees that could recognise this course as optional.

A CV of the teacher including:

- Academic degrees and institutions awarding them.
- Current affiliation and academic rank.
- A list of publications and citations (a link to the author's Google Scholar or ORCID profile with suffice).
- A brief narrative CV (max. 200 words).

Proposals should be submitted ONLINE by the end of February by filling in the course proposal form at <u>www.udc.es/ori/iss/proposal.html</u>. Candidates are encouraged to submit their proposals as early as possible, as this increases their chances of being accepted.
